Objective:

Definition of Philanthropy:

- Having a desire to benefit humanity – a desire to improve the material, social, and spiritual welfare of humanity, especially through charitable activities.
 - Taking philanthropic action or being active in a philanthropic organization
 - Showing a general love for, or benevolence toward, the whole of mankind
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Criteria:

Ages 23 to 38 years

Having performed community service and/or has had a philanthropic impact in the Foundation Service Area within the last 2 years.

Considerations:

Has taken a leadership role in the performance of charitable activities.

Exemplifies to the broader Holland/Zeeland community the important role that young people play in creating the next generation of leadership in philanthropy.

Has enhanced the community through charitable activities.

All awards will be made at the discretion of the Community Foundation.
